

First Test

Text:

Vincent Willem van Gogh is a well-known Dutch painter. During his lifetime, he remained poor and unknown. He was born on 30th March, 1853, to upper middle class parents. He spent his early life working for a firm of art dealers before travelling to The Hague, London, and Paris.

He was deeply religious and aspired to be a pastor like his father. He became a teacher in England, and then he worked as a missionary in a mining region in Belgium, where he drew people from the local community. In 1885, he painted his first major work, "The Potato Eaters." In March 1886, he moved to Paris and discovered the French Impressionists. Later, he moved to the south of France and was influenced by the region's strong sunlight. His paintings grew brighter in colour, and he developed the unique and highly recognizable style that became fully realized during his stay in Arles in 1888.

He suffered from a serious mental disease, and on 9th May, 1889, he asked to be admitted to the asylum at Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, a hospital for the mentally ill. On 27th July, 1890, he shot himself in a lonely field and died two days later, on 29th July, 1890.
