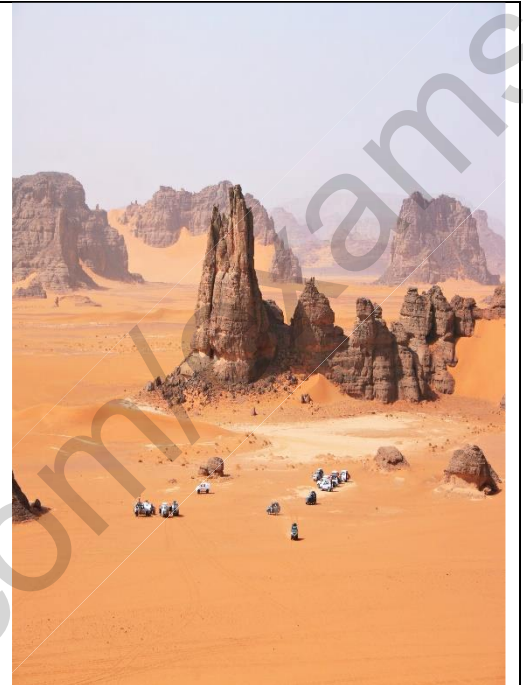
Text:

Tassili N’Ajjer National Park is situated in South East of Algeria at the borders of Libya, Niger and Mali, covering an area of 72,000 sq. km. It is best known for its sandstorm and mountain range, complete with impressive rock arches and paintings, and engravings other landforms. In 1986, UNESCO declared the Tassili N’Ajjer National Park a Biosphere Reserve under its protection, it is second on the IUCN List of Protected Areas. It is home to a number of endangered fauna and flora. The Tassili is the only place on earth where the Saharan Cypress or Tarout, one of the rarest and endangered tree and Saharan Myrtle. It is a home of different endangered animal species like Barbary red deer, Dorcas gazelle.

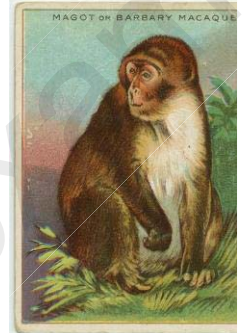
Text :

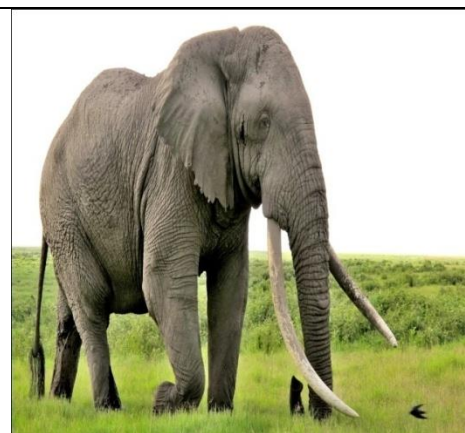

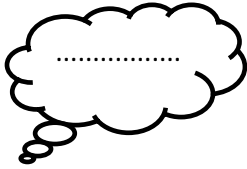

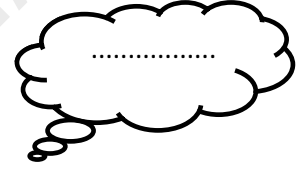

It was started in 1948, IUCN's purpose is to encourage and assist countries around the world to conserve the quality and diversity of nature.

The IUCN Red List of Threatened Species is widely recognized as the most comprehensive, objective global approach for evaluating the conservation status of plant and animal species. It evaluates whether ecosystems have reached the final stage of degradation, whether they are threatened at Critically Endangered, Endangered or Vulnerable levels.

The goal of The IUCN Red List is to provide information and analyses on the status, trends and threats to species in order to inform and catalyze action for biodiversity conservation
